There is another alternative, especially for seniors!

What?



What is a Chromebook?

A Chromebook is a different kind of laptop.

Chromebooks run Google's Chrome Operating System (Chrome OS.) These machines are designed to be used primarily while connected to the Internet, with most applications and documents not on your computer, but living somewhere else ... like in the "cloud."

Chromebooks weren't designed to do everything — they do the basics that <u>most</u> people need, and do that very well.

All about Chrome OS

Using your Chromebook is as easy as surfing the web, using a Chrome browser.

- Zero to web in 10 seconds. Chromebooks start in 10 seconds and resume instantly from power saving mode.
 Websites load quickly and run smoothly.
- Fast experience everywhere. All your apps, documents, and settings are stored "in the cloud."
- Always connected. Its easy to get online anywhere, via Wi-Fi.


Why Not?

SOME LIMITATIONS

Need a free Google Account

Access to the Internet

No application programs



Price

Most \$200-\$500, Some >\$900

Can buy from a variety of stores including Amazon, Costco, Walmart...

30 day return

Frequent sale pricing, watch for Black Friday specials

Ease of Setup

Connect to Network

Log in with Google/Gmail account

Can personalize picture, background, mouse size, home pages

Pin frequently used programs/apps to the shelf

Screen

Screen Size-11.6 inches to 15 inches

Optional Touch Screen, HD Screen, faster processor - adds about \$100 or more

Some Models - Flippable Screen I.e. tablet

Other Options

Backlit Keyboard

Processor-Intel Celeron or Core i3

RAM - 2GB or 4GB - preferable

Battery Life

Exceptional

10 hours on average (vs. Windows 6.5 hours)

Storage

16GB, 32GB or 64BG

Micro SD or USB External Drive

Security

Chrome OS does not allow executable programs to be installed

Some web apps can be malicious.

But all that is needed is to do a HARD RESET.

Multiple Users

Just log in with new account - each with their own settings

Can also use guest mode (like incognito)

Can also add supervised users (like parental controls)

Automatic Updates

One of the best features

Updates download in the background

When you see an up arrow in bottom right, restart

You can also go to settings and check for updates

Cloud Based Activities

All Google Suite Apps -Docs, Sheets, Slides and Forms

MS Word, Excel online

Other sites like Facebook, Banking, Airline Reservations, Office Online, etc.

Chrome/Google Syncing

Will sync with other devices

Can turn off syncing

Android/Chrome Apps

Google Play Store ... coming

Many useful apps and extensions, like your cell phone

Limitations

Limited Hard Drive Storage

Can Use External Hard Drive or Thumb Drive or Micro SD card

Cloud Based Storage such as Google Drive (even OneDrive)

100 GB storage Free for 2 Years

No Installable Programs ... yet

- Photoshop
- Quicken
- Skype

OR

Intense graphic games

Limitations

No Optical Drive

Keeps weight and cost lower

Many newer laptops do not have CD/DVD drive either

Can stream with Chromecast device or HDMI

Recommended Specs - 4 GB memory, 32 GB Storage

Major Manufacturers - Acer, ASUS, Samsung, Dell, HP, Lenovo

Shop around, get some prices

Online - Amazon.com and Costco
both allow returns within 30 days

Keyboard Has Different Keys



When things go wrong, a "Hard Reset" is easy

Press and Hold
Refresh+Power on
your keyboard.
Chrome OS will shut
down and reboot.



Sign in to your Chromebook and open Chrome browser. A restore window will open. Click X in the upper right corner. The window will close. **Note: Do NOT click on Restore. If you click on Restore, this will reopen the malicious web page and lock your browser again!**
