Chromebooks provide general computer users with a simplified computing experience that's unmatched by any of their Windows or Mac rivals.

What is a Chromebook?

- A Chromebook is a different kind of laptop.
- Chromebooks run Google's Chrome OS Operating
 System and the Google Chrome Browser
- Chromebooks weren't designed to do everything —
 they do the basics that most people need, and do
 that very well.

Why a Chromebook?


- **Chromebooks** are available in a wide assortment of sizes, shapes, prices \$200-\$400 +, many suppliers.
- Long battery life, and speedy performance without price premiums.
- If your into word processing, email, internet searching and/or video streaming, the best
 Chromebooks will be a perfect fit for you.

If you spend more than 90 percent of your computer time in a web browser, you should have no trouble using a Chromebook ... as your primary PC, and in some cases, maybe as your only computer.

Why a Chromebook?

"In general, the Chrome OS operating system just works and gets out of your way. Sure there are limitations and there are things that don't work from time to time, but for the most part, if your workflow can exist inside a Chromebook's limitations, you will find yourself loving the experience of operating in Chrome OS."

The Chrome Browser

- Microsoft has been testing pop-ups that are beckoning their users to say no to Chrome and Firefox.
- That is fine, good marketing, but ...
 Chrome is the dominant surfing platform and all of its competitors will have to put in some serious work if they ever plan to supplant the King of the browsers.

Microsoft backs off from Windows 10 'warning' about Chrome and Firefox - it's just a test.

SOME LIMITATIONS

Need a free Google Account - easy!

Access to the Internet, wi-fi is everywhere, the Chromebook has some offline capability

No application programs, but lots of Chrome Extensions and thousands of Apps available to Chrome OS users.

Chrome Extensions & Apps?

- Extensions are small programs that customize the browsing experience. They enable users to tailor Chrome functionality and behavior to meet their individual needs or preferences.
- Chrome Apps are web applications that run on the Google Chrome web browser.
- Chrome Apps, Extensions, and Themes can be obtained from the Chrome Web Store.

More Apps - Google Play Store?



- Google Play is a digital distribution service operated and developed by Google. It serves as the official App Store for the Android operating system, allowing users to browse and download applications.
- Google Play is available for most Chromebooks!

- Most newer wi-fi printers come Google cloud-print ready.
- Wireless printer required.
- There is an "HP Print for Chrome"
 Extension that makes the task of printing to an HP printer pretty simple.


My Computing Devices

- A Dell All in One Desktop 23 inch screen,
 1TB memory, Windows 10 (\$690), Onedrive, always concerned about updates, security and backup
 - Not mobile no collaboration, sign-on every time and software updates (slow)
 - Adobe Photoshop and Lightroom share with 2 devices, but my use is declining - other alternatives
 - Quicken replaced with Google Sheets on CB
 - Word, Excel and Powerpoint stored, can transfer to CB - Google Docs, Sheets and Slides, as needed








3 Line "Hamburger" Menu

1) 3 Lines – Menu

In Google Classroom, mobile versions of Google Docs, and more places, you will see 3 lines in the upper left hand corner. These lines are sometimes referred to as "the hamburger." Touch or click these 3 lines to reveal the menu. Anytime you see these 3 lines, click on them to see what other options you have.







3 Vertical Dots More Options

2) 3 Dots – More Actions


When you see 3 dots in an icon this indicates there are more options. Click once on a file in Google Drive and the 3 dots "more actions" icon will appear in the toolbar. Click on this icon to reveal more options about the item you have selected.




Chromebook - My Drive



CB - My Drive









- Answers for what you don't know are only a click away
- Easy dealing with MS documents and a wide variety of sources and files

Google Drive and Google Docs

- Google makes it easier and easier to open and edit documents of any type without the need for any sort of separate program.
- With Google Drive, you can open up most any document (including PDFs) and start editing it as a Google document. You can save it as that same original file type, or as one of a number of other popular formats, and then share it with whomever in whatever style they prefer.
- Google introduced another update to Google Drive that makes quick, collective document markup even easier.

Google Drive and Google Docs

Unless you really need Office 365 or Word Online or Excel Online, life has really gotten much easier.

Some Learning Needed (2)

- Using previously stored MS Word, Excel and PowerPoint - where are they? On a hard drive, in an email, OneDrive, a thumb drive or an external hard drive
- Get them into My Google Drive, copy and paste, drag or drop, right click.
- Once in My Google Drive, New, File Upload, Select ...
 creates


Some Learning Needed (3)

- Problem Solving
- My Samsung Chromebook Plus was periodically locking up, and over time it got worse and worse.
- Performed the "Powerwash," to do a factory reset.
- Utilized the "Chromebook Recovery Utility" (Chrome web store - create an image), all to no avail and I did notice it seemed to be running warm - maybe even hot as time went on.
- It was still under warranty, just barely 9 days, sent it back and the motherboard was replaced.
