



"Chromebooks provide general computer users with a simplified and "easier computing experience" that's unmatched by any of their Windows or Mac rivals."

#### What is a Chromebook

- Chromebooks are a special kind of laptop running
   Google's Chrome OS Operating System.
- Chromebooks weren't designed to do everything but they do the basics that most people want and need, and they do that very well.
- Chromebooks use the Google Chrome browser, the most popular web browser in the world!


If you can use a browser, you can use a Chromebook!

#### Why a Chromebook?

- Easy out of the box, no setup required, no slowdowns
- Light weight, portable, excellent battery life
- Protection is built in, no need for anti-virus
- Quick, fast startup, easy access to the Internet
- All files are easy access, sync across multiple machines
- Automatic saving, never lose your work
- Free Google Drive Storage, free storage for Google Suite products - Google Docs, Google Sheets, Google Slides, Google Drawing and many more
- Multiple users on same machine
- Chrome Web Store free apps
- No purchasing software, cost is right, good value

#### Why a Chromebook?

- If your into word processing, email, internet searching, photos, news, online shopping, video streaming, etc. a Chromebook is probably a perfect fit for you.
- Chromebooks are available in a wide assortment of sizes, shapes, features, memory, processors, resolution, etc. All are very light weight and mobile with long battery life, and speedy performance
- Chromebooks prices generally range from \$200-\$500, with many premium and bargain devices, from many suppliers.


#### Why a Chromebook?


If you spend more than 90 percent of your computer time in <u>a web browser</u>, you will have no trouble using a Chromebook ... as your primary PC, and in some cases, maybe as your only computer.

#### Why Not a Chromebook?

- Limited storage, yes, but ...
- Cloud Storage It's on the Internet, yes, but ...
- Chromebooks can be slow, yes, but ...
- Cloud Printing over your home network, yes, but ...
- Need internet connection, most of the time, yes, but ...
- No professional video editing, yes, but ...
- No Photoshop, yes, but ... it's coming, and there are alternatives - PixIr and Google Photos for photo editing
- Very limited sophisticated online gaming
- Cannot install programs, yes, but ...

#### My Chromebook

Acer Chromebook 14"



Used daily - no hardware problems



1. Usual stuff, surfing, banking, stock market, travel, etc, etc.

2. Google Docs for letters, replaces Word

Google Drive for backup. 15 GB freeNo longer use Dropbox.

5. Google Slides for presentations like this one

6. Google Sheets for spreadsheets, replaces Excel.

### And now, what I like about my Chromebook

1. Fast, doesn't slow down over time like PC's

2. Boots up in about 10 seconds

3. Lightweight, 3 lbs 5 oz

4. Don't need Anti-Virus program

Microsoft Office not neededGoogle Docs does all I need, free

6. Updates are simple and quick - just reboot, done in 1-2 mins

7. Solid state hard drive



8. My stuff is available on any computer, phone or tablet...just log into Chrome browser

9. Easy navigation via Bookmarks and shortcuts on Shelf (or Taskbar)

10. I never get this message!



- The very popular Chrome Browser, many Chrome Apps & Extensions, and lots of Bookmarks
- Gmail, Google Calendar, Google Search, YouTube
- Google Drive Google Docs (Word), Google Sheets (Excel), Google Slides (PowerPoint), Drawing (Publisher)
   Google Sites for website building, import and convert my previously stored Microsoft files and edit as needed,
- Google Photos, My CB Blog, Facebook, read News & Kindle, check the weather, Google Maps for travel, Quicken replacement, letters, envelopes, scan websites, store and edit camera and cell phone photos, Micro-SD Card & Thumb drives for External Storage, collaborate (Share) files with others easy


#### What do I like most?

# What's not to like? Not much!


- Dealing with Change things are different,

- Moving files not always a simple copy or cut and paste, sometimes it's a drag and drop
- Always questions, answers for what you don't know are only a click away - Google Search, YouTube - dates
- Slow your Internet Speed, and processor
- Some trial and error, patience
- Platform End-Of-Lile Updates for five years after hits the market, but Google is reevaluating its Auto Update Policy -AUP, check it out




