## CREATE A FILE ON YOUR COMPUTER

- **Document/table or Spreadsheet list on your computer.**
- **If you don't want to encrypt the information, be sure NOT to name the file "passwords.docx or .xlsx.**
- **At least choose an innocuous or unlikely to be figured out password file name. MomsGarden. DadsShop or DogsMeds.**

## FILE ENCRYPTION PROGRAMS

**Whether you want to store sensitive data on a USB drive, securely email it, put it in a safe deposit box (which means frequent visit to the bank during the year) or just add an additional layer of security on your hard drive, there are a variety of ways to protect your files with a password.**

# PASSWORDS

## FILE ENCRYPTION PROGRAMS

When we say we're "password protecting" a file, we generally mean we're encrypting the file so it can't be decrypted and understood without your encryption password. That's the most secure way to password protect files.

Most computers will require a program, and most are not free, in order to encrypt files on your computer so you will have to balance the cost with the value of protecting your files.

## ICLOUD KEYCHAIN FOR APPLE

### What is iCloud Keychain

- **Ability to store personal account information and passwords in a way that is secure and easy to access.**
- **In other words, iCloud Keychain keeps passwords and credit card information up to date across all approved devices.**
- **Your data is encrypted and cannot be read by Apple.**

## Microsoft Edge

- **Settings**
- **View Advanced Settings at the bottom**
- **Scroll down to Privacy and services**
- **Toggle Offer to Save Passwords on or off.**
- **Close Edge and reopen.**

# PASSWORDS BROWSERS

## Google Chrome

- **Settings**
- **Show Advance Settings at the bottom**
- **Scroll down below Privacy to Passwords and Forms.**
- **Here you can enable or disable Autofill to fill out webforms in a single click and manage the autofill settings.**

# PASSWORDS BROWSERS

## Google Chrome

- **AND you can enable or disable the offer for Chrome to save passwords with Google Smart Lock for Passwords and manage those passwords here.**
- **Close and reopen Chrome if you make changes.**

# PASSWORDS BROWSERS

## Firefox

### If Firefox does not prompt you to save passwords

- **In the prompt: To have Firefox remember your username and password, click on Remember Password-Remember. The next time you visit the website, Firefox will automatically enter your username and password for you.**



# PASSWORDS MY METHOD

- **When I get to a new site and before I sign in/register, I plan my log in AND my password and write them down prior to filling in the Sign In process.**
- **Remember, sometimes a site will not accept a certain length of password or will require a certain combination that must be at least a certain of letters, numbers and/or characters.**

# PASSWORDS

There are a number of very good password managers including: Dashlane, Keeper Password Manager, LastPass Premium, RoboForm and more. It is worth the price to subscribe to these services.
