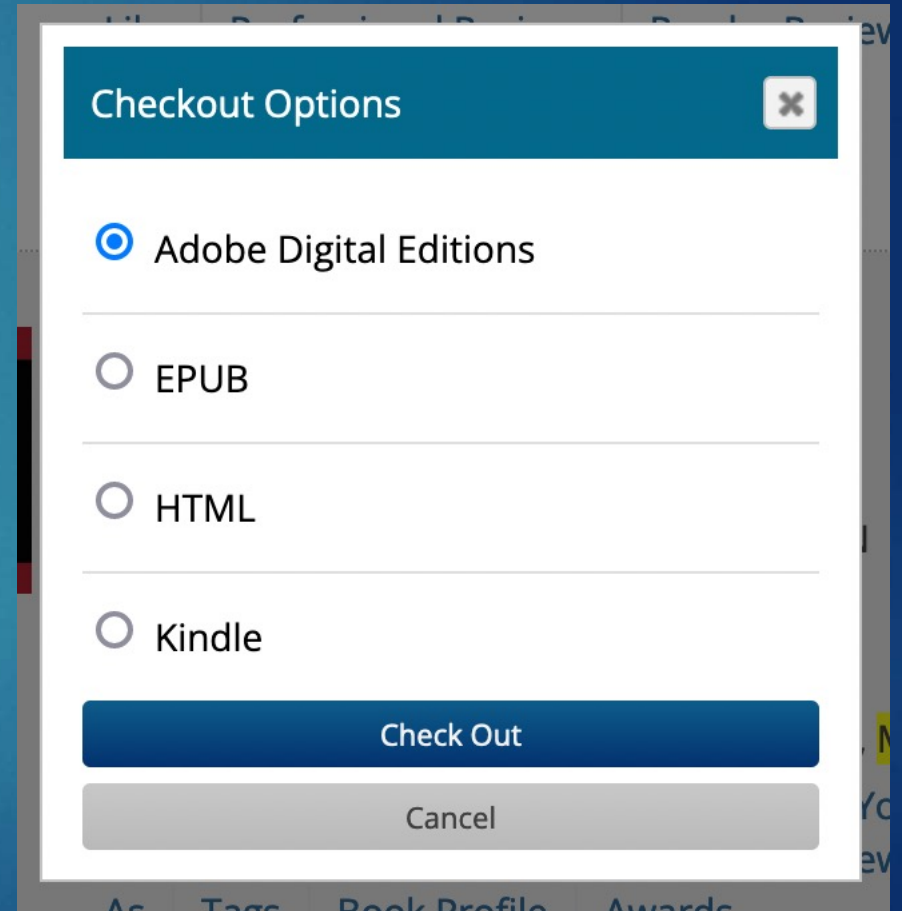

- ▶ If your library offers kindle books as downloads, here is how you go about getting them.

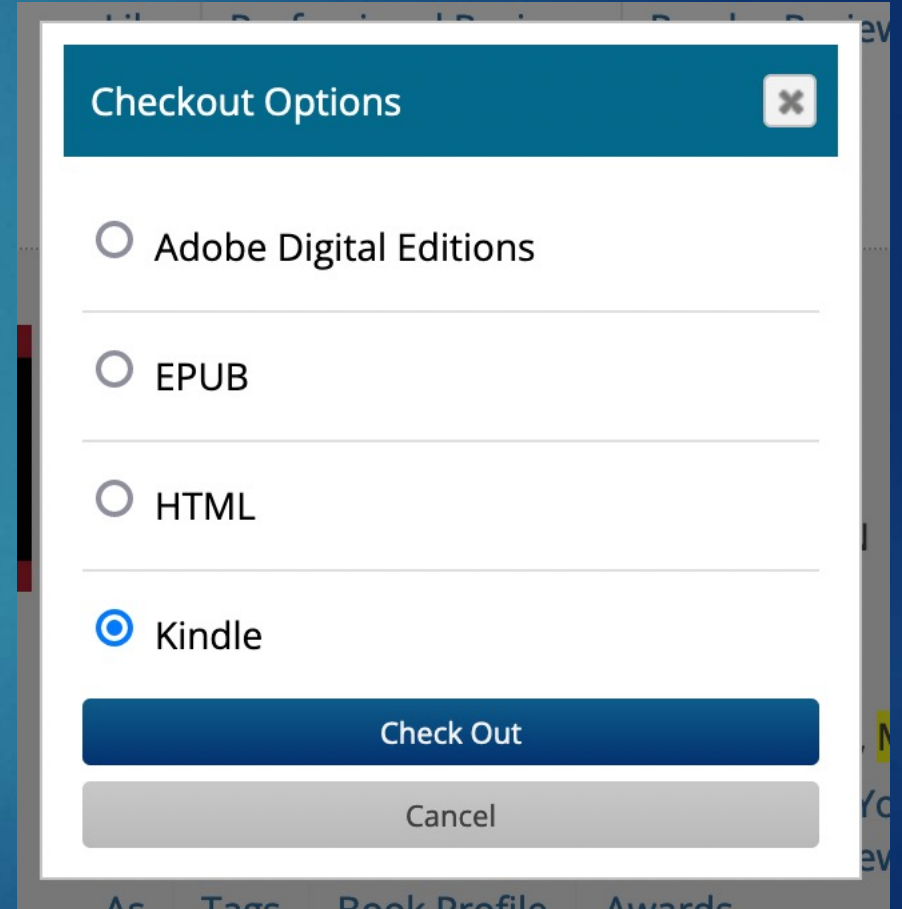

- ▶ Browse your libraries digital books and look for Kindle edition books listed.





# Library Apps

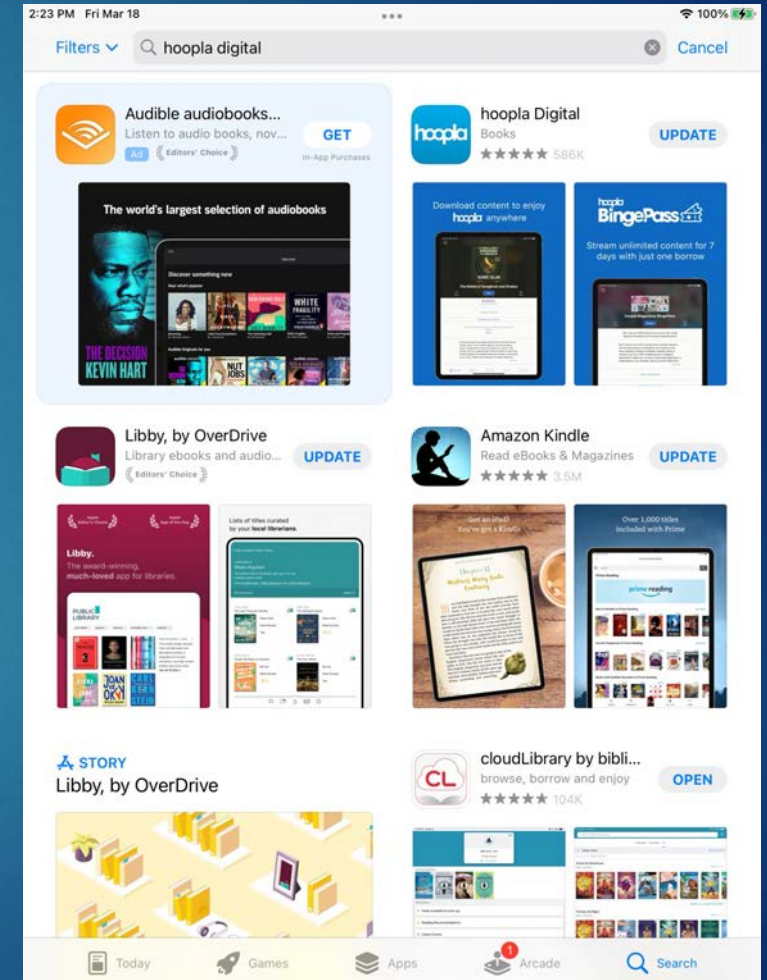
