HOW DID GOOGLE PHOTOS CHANGE?

- As with most of Google's services, they are updating logos and menus and the user interface.
- Photos has removed the 3 line menu AND the 3 dot menu
- There are now 5 "buttons" which include

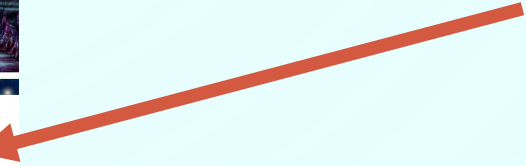
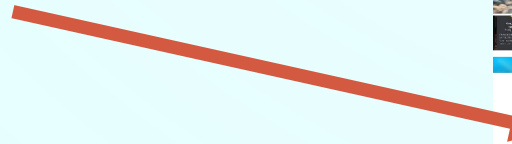
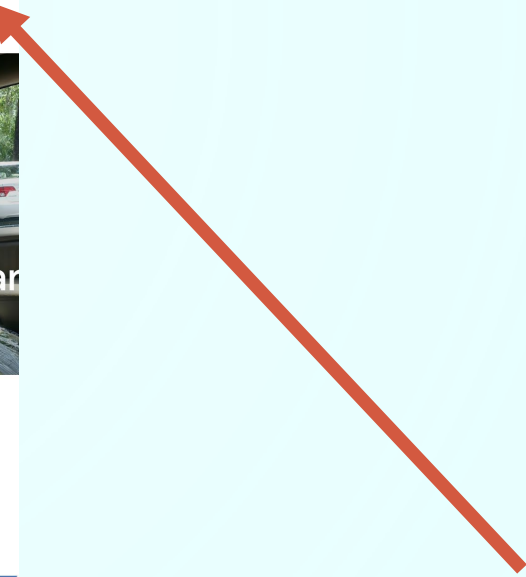
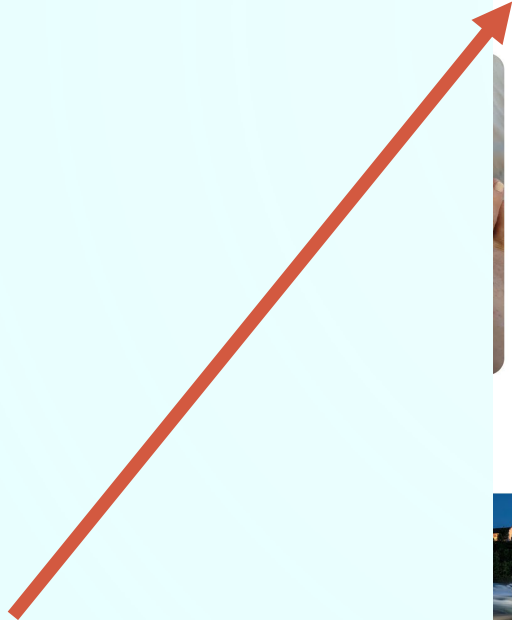
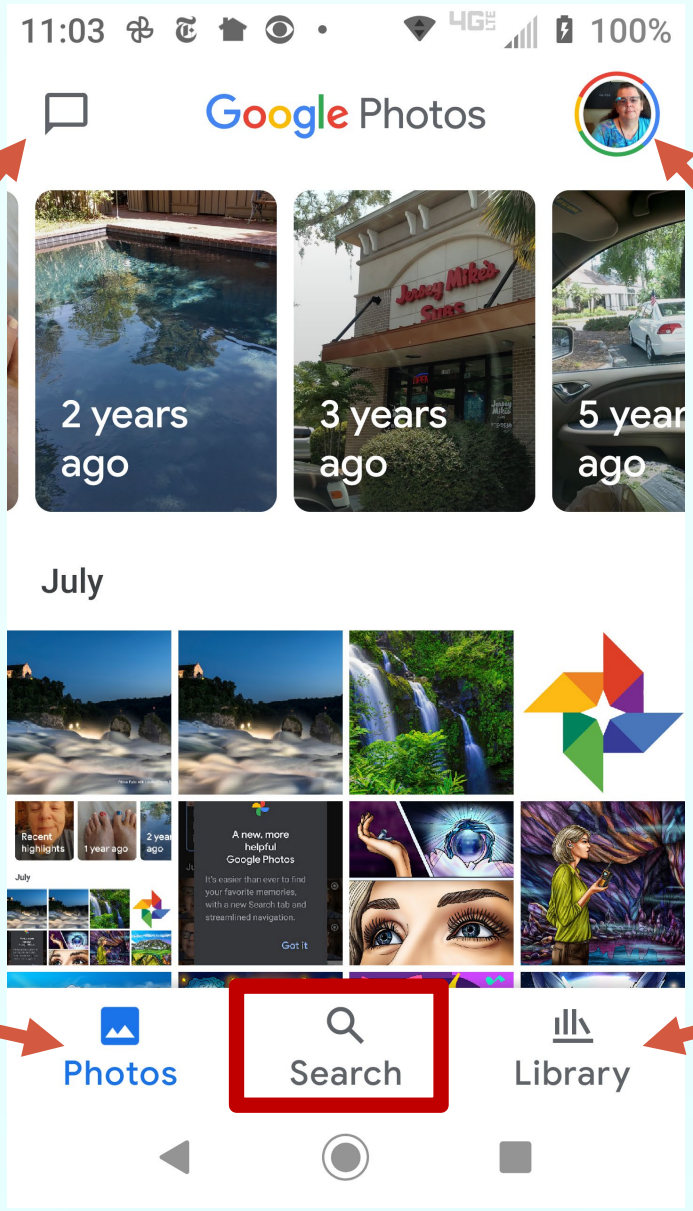

IS GOOGLE PHOTOS SECURE?

- **Overall Google Photos is fairly secure. It doesn't automatically post your photos for everyone to see. People won't be able to google for them. The pictures that you upload are only viewable by you — unless, of course, you share them with other people.**
- **In other words, your photos are never posted publicly. Only YOU have access to them unless you share them specifically with others.**

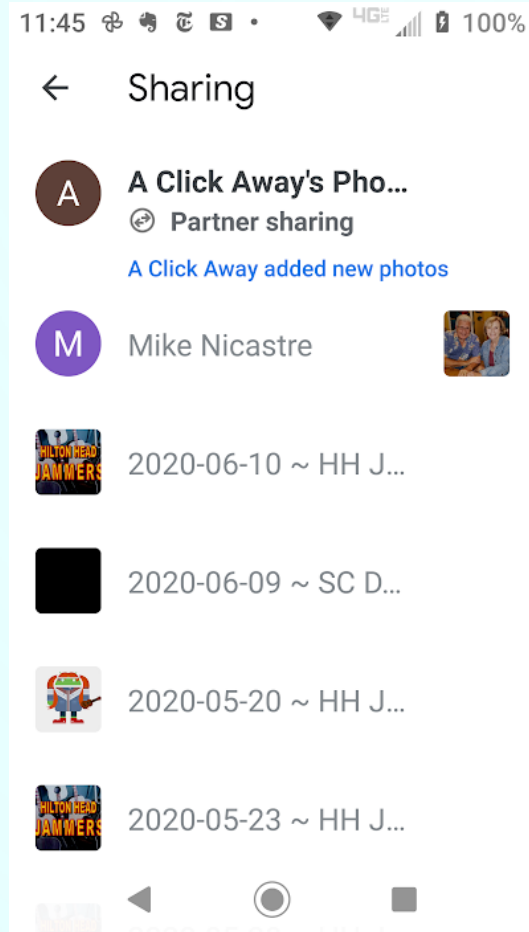
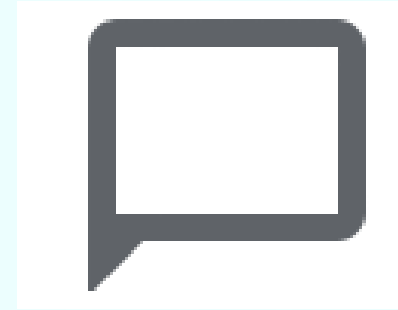

You can begin a “conversation” in this section. Sharing back and forth and commenting on the shared items.

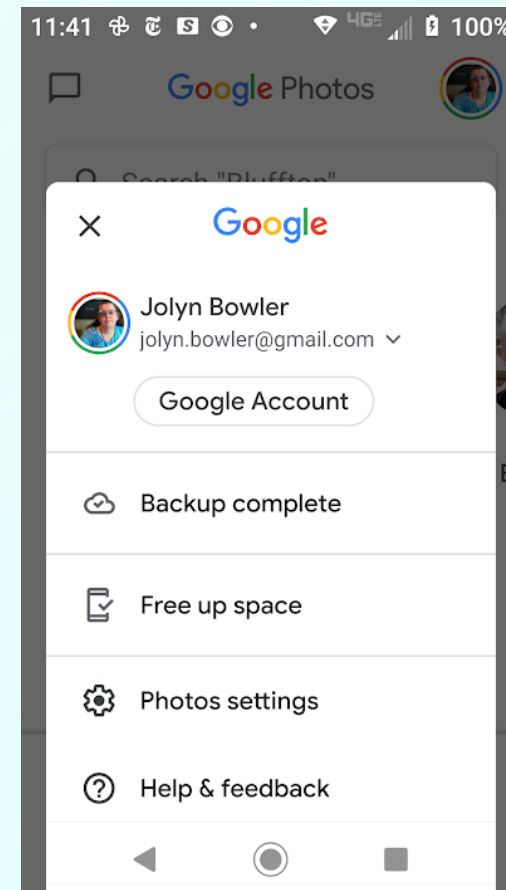


AVATAR/ICON/ACCOUNT SETTINGS

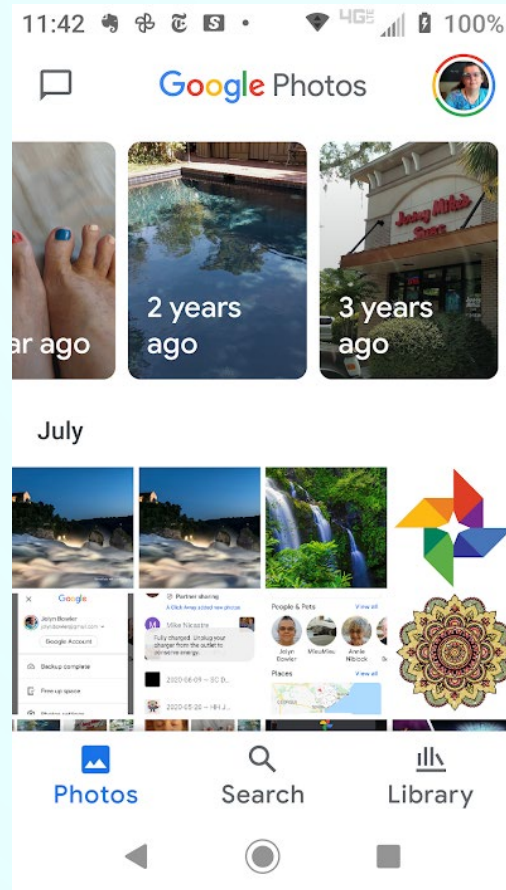


In lieu of the menu icons, Photos has replaced the 3-dot menu with your Avatar. Click and you will access your

- free up space safely on your phone and keep your photos in Google Photos

PHOTOS



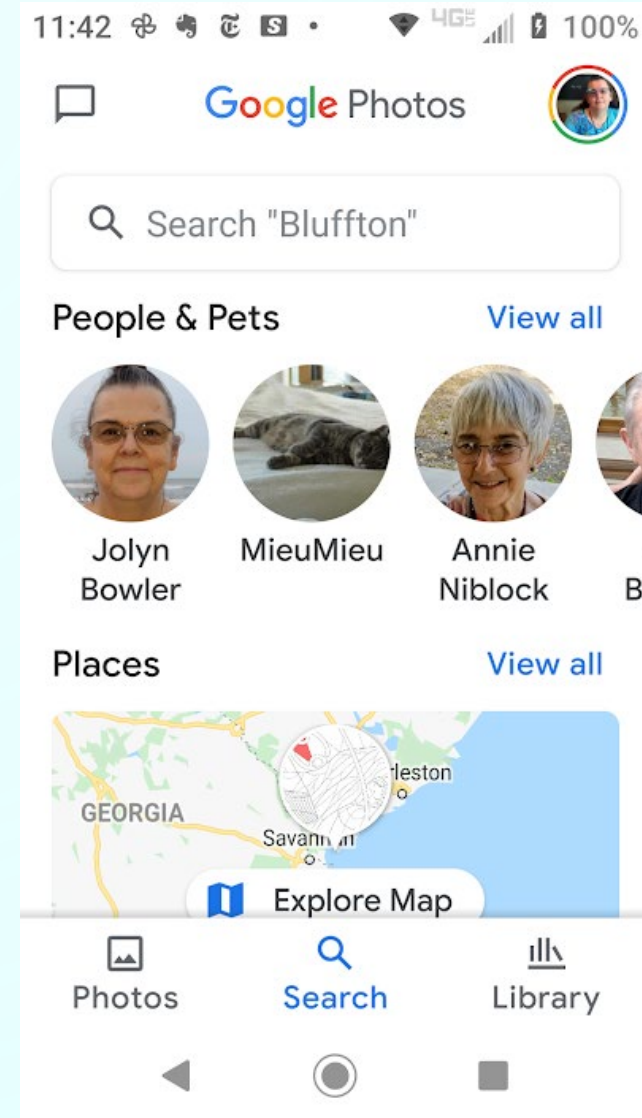
Your photos bin is still there and Google Photos also has added a highlights row at the top. Scroll down a bit and the “handle” will appear on the right so you can scroll down. The ability to pinch or spread two fingers to see a larger image is also possible.

SEARCH



The Search icon takes you to a screen where you can search within your photos just as you would do a Google search over the Internet.

Additionally, they have added Places. This will automatically put your photos in place on a Google Map. If you do not see your images on the map, you can add location data within one or a group of photos.

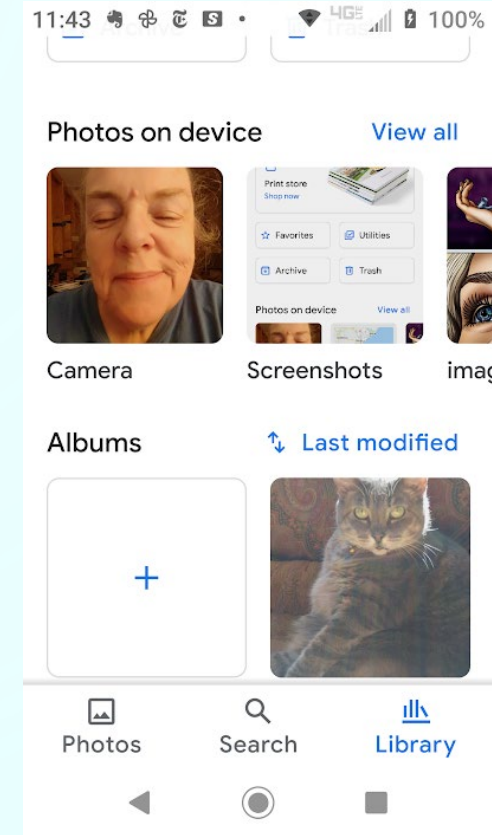
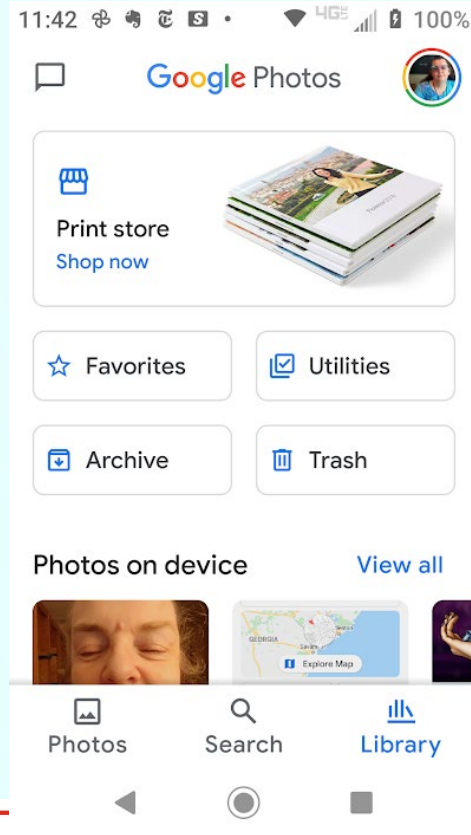
