



Gmail is:

A popular email service used by millions of people around the world provided by Google that offers a variety of features:

- Security Two-step verification process to protect user accounts and recovery email/phone number as well.
- A large storage capacity ~ Email Storage Gmail offers 15 GB of free storage space. There are paid/subscription offers as well.
- The ability to send and receive emails from any device
- Organization automatically categorization of emails into Primary,
 Social and Promotions categories, as well as into user-defined labels.
 - Search The power of Google Search allows users to quickly find emails by sender, recipient, subject, words or phrases from the message body, and more.



Labels – Organize your emails by Name or Topic. These are like folders in other email services.

Filters – Allows users to automatically categorize, archive, delete, star, or forward incoming emails.

Spam Protection – Incudes an effective spam filter that keeps most unwanted emails from reaching the user's inbox.

• Chat – Gmail has an integrated chat feature, which allows users to communicate in real-time with other Gmail users.

The best use/setup/operation of Gmail is via the website: https://mail.google.com

Regardless of where and how you access your Gmail account, it is best, if possible, to sign-up and setup via the web.

Gmail is a "web-based" web service.

HOWEVER

Google offers email apps for Gmail on Apple iPhone and iPad as well as on Android phones and tablets and A PWA (progressive web app) on Chromebooks.



SECURITY/SETTINGS


As you set up your Gmail account, you will have gone through a series of steps to fill out. You can, if you prefer, not set up extra security at that time, but it is recommended to everyone to use some form of Two-Factor Authentication (2FA). Yes, it can be a bit of a pain and you need to remember to have your phone with you if that is your confirmation method.

Come into the Center for help and you can sign in on your laptop or on one of our systems. Then set your security and any other settings in Gmail and it will reflect in your phone or tablet app.

Go to either google.com or sign into your Gmail account and then go to your security settings.

Remember to log out/sign out when you are done... we are a public facility.





Google/Gmail security settings I

2-Step Verification

2-Step Verification is an extra layer of security that helps protect your account from unauthorized access. When you enable 2-Step Verification, you will need to enter a code from your phone in addition to your password when you sign in. It makes it much more difficult for someone to access your account if they have your password.

App Passwords

App Passwords are special passwords that you can use to sign into Gmail from third-party apps. This helps protect your account if the third-party app is compromised. To create an App Password, go to the Security tab in your Gmail settings and click App Passwords.

Security Checkup

The Security Checkup is a tool that helps you review and adjust your security settings. It also recommends additional security measures that you can take to protect your account. To run the Security Checkup, go to the Security tab in your Gmail settings and click Security Checkup.



Google/Gmail security settings II

Inactivity Alerts

Inactivity Alerts notify you if there is any sign of unusual activity in your account. For example, if someone logs in from a new device or location, you will receive an email notification. To enable Inactivity Alerts, go to the **Security** tab in your Gmail settings and click **Inactivity Alerts**.

Device Activity

The Device Activity page shows you a list of all the devices that have been used to access your account recently. You can use this information to identify any unauthorized devices and revoke their access. To view your Device Activity, go to the **Security** tab in your Gmail settings and click **Device Activity**.

Recent Activity

The Recent Activity page shows you a list of all the recent activity in your account, such as sent and received emails, and changes to your settings. You can use this information to identify any suspicious activity and take steps to protect your account.



Once you are in your account page, take the time to wander through the settings on the left.





Use one from a different service (Apple ID or Microsoft ID)


Create a new one just for recovery purposes.


