





WHY YOU NEED THE FREE HHICC PASSWORD LOG BOOK

Even if you use password manager software it is a good idea to keep a written log of your passwords for at least two reasons.

First, all devices can fail and unless your password software is cloud based you may lose that information.

Second, and most importantly, your digital information needs to be available to your spouse, children, or lawyer in the event of your passing. Unfortunately our volunteers have encountered many instances where a survivor had no idea how to access a deceased spouse's information. This will cause stress and difficulties at a most inopportune time.



Digital Safety

- Scammers Are Everywhere (trying to earn a living!)
 - Phone Calls
 - Emails
 - Texts
 - Social Media (Facebook, TikTok, etc.)
- They are trying to get information about you that they can sell
 - Credit Card info
 - Bank Account info
 - Social Security and Birth Date
- Or they are trying to get you to send them money

SCAM Emails



Check the senders Domain

- @xxxxxx.xxx
- If it's not a company.com, spelled correctly, do not trust it
 If you don't trust it, DO NOT Unsubscribe!!!
- Move the email to your junk
- Also, you can go to your mail provider settings and block the domain

Fake Tech Support

- Warning message on a website with a phone number to call
- Searching the web for a phone number to call for tech help
- Unsolicited phone call offering help
- In every case, just say no!
 - Do not let anyone take over your computer unless you know certainly that they are a "trusted provider"
 - Do not purchase an annual contract.

Some Simple Rules

- Do not use a password more than once
- Have a way to store and retrieve all of the user name and passwords for all of your different accounts.
 - Password Managers, Document stored in the cloud (iCloud, Google Cloud, OneDrive) – should be encrypted, or written in a notebook or password book stored not on your desktop.
- Don't click on emails or texts from unknown senders especially if it's a deal. Don't unsubscribe – just mark it as junk.
- Beware of deals in emails, Messenger, Facebook, TikTok, NextDoor
 - If it seems really good, it may be a total fake






