Used daily - no hardware problems



1. Usual stuff, email, surfing, banking, stock market, travel, etc.



2. Google Docs for letters, replaces Word



3. Google Drive for backup. 15 GB free No longer use Dropbox.



4. Google Slides for presentations like this one



5. Google Sheets for spreadsheets, replaces Excel.

1. Fast, doesn't slow down over time like PC's

2. Boots up in about 10 seconds

3. Lightweight, 3 lbs 5 oz

4. Can't get a virus or Ransomware.

No Anti-Virus program needed.


