- IT IS PREFERRED BY MANY OVER EMAIL, FAX ETC..
- IT IS EASY TO SEND/ RECEIVE PHOTOS IN HIGH QUALITY
- CAN SEND LARGER FILES VS EMAIL
- KEEPS A SIMPLE LOG OF TEXTS
- SEAMLESS SHARING ON ALL APPLE DEVICES
- ONLY WAY TO REACH GRANDKIDS !!



About iMessage and SMS/MMS

Learn why some of your message bubbles are blue or green.

You can use the Messages app on your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch to send messages. Those messages are sent as iMessage or SMS/MMS. Learn more about the difference between the message types.

iMessage



iMessages are texts, photos, or videos that you send to iOS devices and Macs over Wi-Fi or cellular-data networks. These messages are

SMS/MMS



If you aren't using iMessage, you can use SMS/MMS. These messages are texts and photos that you send to other cell phones or iOS

VOICE CREATED MESSAGES

- SELECT PERSON TO RECEIVE (CURRENT STRING OR NEW)
- GO TO MESSAGE SPACE AND MICROPHONE IMAGE AT BOTTOM AND PUSH
- TALK AND IT TYPES OUT YOUR MESSAGE
- BE SURE IT SAYS WHAT YOU WANT
- SEND

GROUP MESSAGES

- Send a group message on your iPhone, iPad, or iMAC
- With Messages, you can send a message to a group of people.
- Top right push box with pen inserted
- Type names of those to receive the message.
- Touch in message box , create message and send ...
- You can also name your group, add or remove people from the group, mute notifications or leave the group. Tap addressees at top and rename ..



NEW OPTION FOR IOS14 USERS "INLINE REPLY"

- How to inline reply in Messages on iPhone
- This pulls a message from many in a string and creates a REPLY message for it .
- 1. Open the Messages app on your iPhone and open a message.
- 2. Tap and hold the message you want to separate and reply to. Hold it until you see the pop-up menu.
- 3. Tap "Reply." Send to someone

SHARING A CONTACT



A few options show up here, including AirDrop and various messaging options like and Mail. Pick whichever one works best for you, but we're going to just share it in message.

Here's how to send animated effects in the Messages app:


- Open your Messages app and select the contact or group you want to message.
- Type your text message in the iMessage bar as you normally would.
- Tap and hold down the blue arrow until the "Send with effect" screen appears.
- Tap Screen.






ADDING EMOJI FOR FUN

Send photo messages

- 1. In a message conversation, tap [ii].
- 2. Tap Camera.
- 3. Tap O to take a photo. Then tap Done.
- 4. To send, tap ♠. If you don't want to send the photo, tap ⊗ in the upper-right corner of the photo.


OR SEND FROM PHOTOS STORAGE

- OPEN PHOTOS
- SELECT PHOTO TO SHARE
- 3. TAP SHARE BUTTON
- 4. SELECT ADDRESSEE AND ADD MESSAGES
- 5. SFND
