# What is Apple ID?

“An Apple ID is the personal account you use to access Apple services like the App Store, iCloud, Messages, the Apple Online Store, FaceTime, and more. It includes the information you use to sign in, as well as all the contact, payment, and security details that you’ll use across Apple services.” — Apple

---

# When do I use my Apple ID?

“Any time you set up a new device, make a purchase, or use any Apple service, you will be asked to sign in with your Apple ID and password. Once signed in you’ll have access to the service and all the personal information in your account. Use the same Apple ID everywhere you sign in to ensure that all your Apple services and devices work together seamlessly and you can access your personal content from all your devices.” — —Apple

# Your Apple ID

- Do not share one.
  - Each person needs his own
  - You can set up Family Sharing later





You are asked to create your ID when you set up your first device. You will need...

- Your full name
  - **Birthdate**
  - Email address
  - Phone number...cell highly preferable
-

If you don't have an Apple ID, create it by going to the App Store and clicking "sign in" to see this message



 **Sign in to download from the App Store.**

If you have an Apple ID, sign in with it here. If you have used the iTunes Store or iCloud, for example, you have an Apple ID. If you don't have an Apple ID, click Create Apple ID.



# Your Apple ID

- During initial setup you are given a choice of turning on two factor authentication. Do it to increase security. If you choose not to you will be required to set up 3 security questions.
  - **WRITE THEM DOWN...THEY ARE AS IMPORTANT AS YOUR PASSWORD**

## If you forget your Apple ID, password, or security questions ...

- You will be locked out of your account if you enter the wrong password too many times (usually more than 3)
  - You cannot access your iCloud data or services
  - You will be unable to purchase apps, music, etc. from the App Store

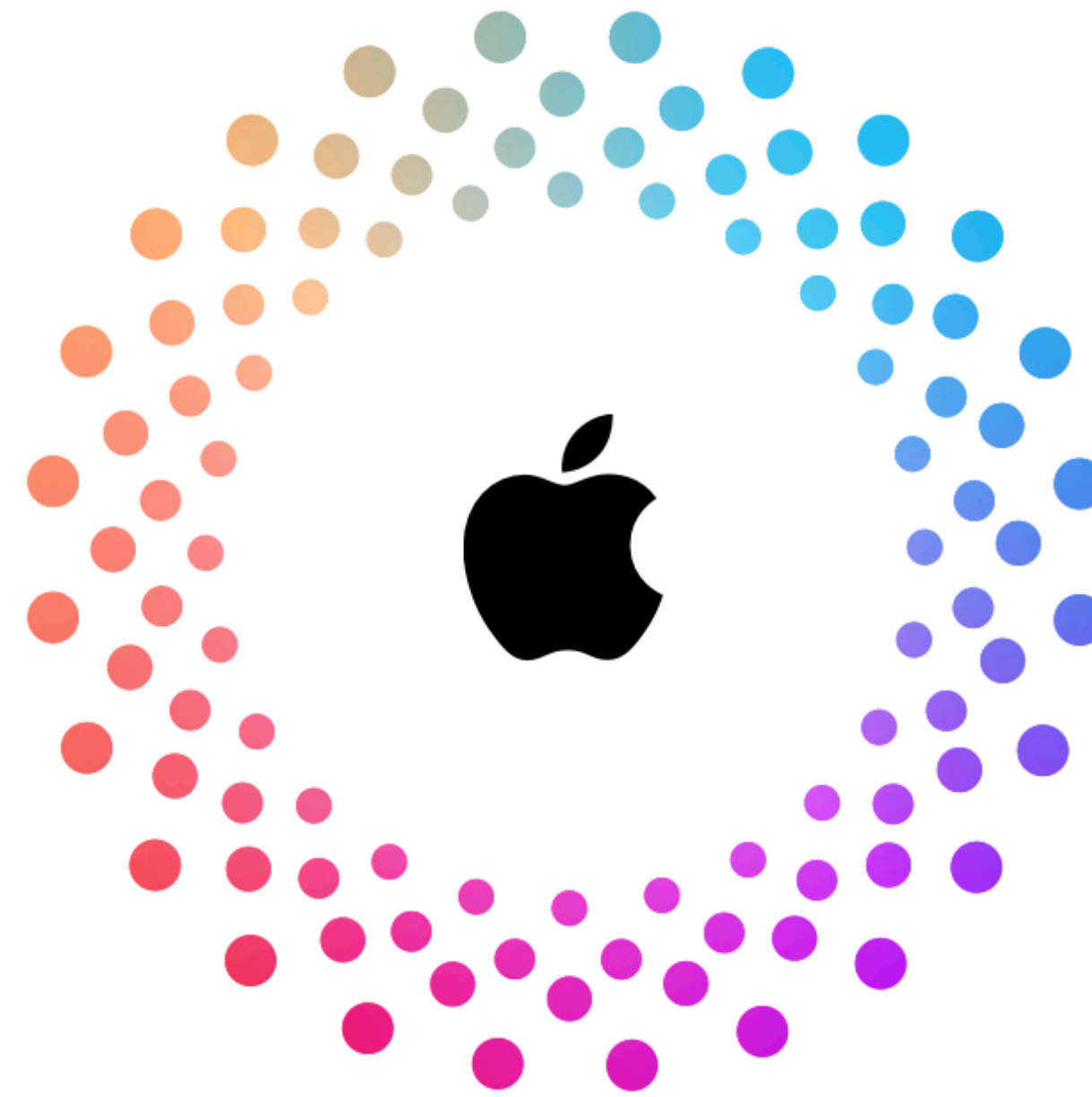

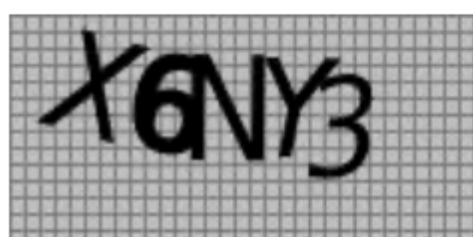



**Creates your Apple / iCloud  
account**

Provides 5 gigabytes of cloud storage and  
allows backup of your important data

Additional storage may be purchased for as little as 99¢/month

**Allows you access to your data  
in iCloud from any device**

What does your Apple ID do?

**Allows you to use Pages,  
Numbers & Keynote when  
signed in on any computer.  
(not on iPad or iPhone)**

**Allows your devices to share information using iCloud**

Contacts, files, photos, notes, calendars, Safari bookmarks, passwords, etc.

will sync across Apple devices seamlessly

What does your Apple ID do?



**Provides access to the App Store**

All apps screened for malicious software and designed to work seamlessly with your device (over 1 million apps available to accomplish any task)

What does your Apple ID do?

**Allows sign in to apps/websites**

When you see “sign in with Apple” you can use your ID and password for secure sign in. App will then use Face ID, or Touch ID to authenticate you.


(You must use two factor authentication to do this)

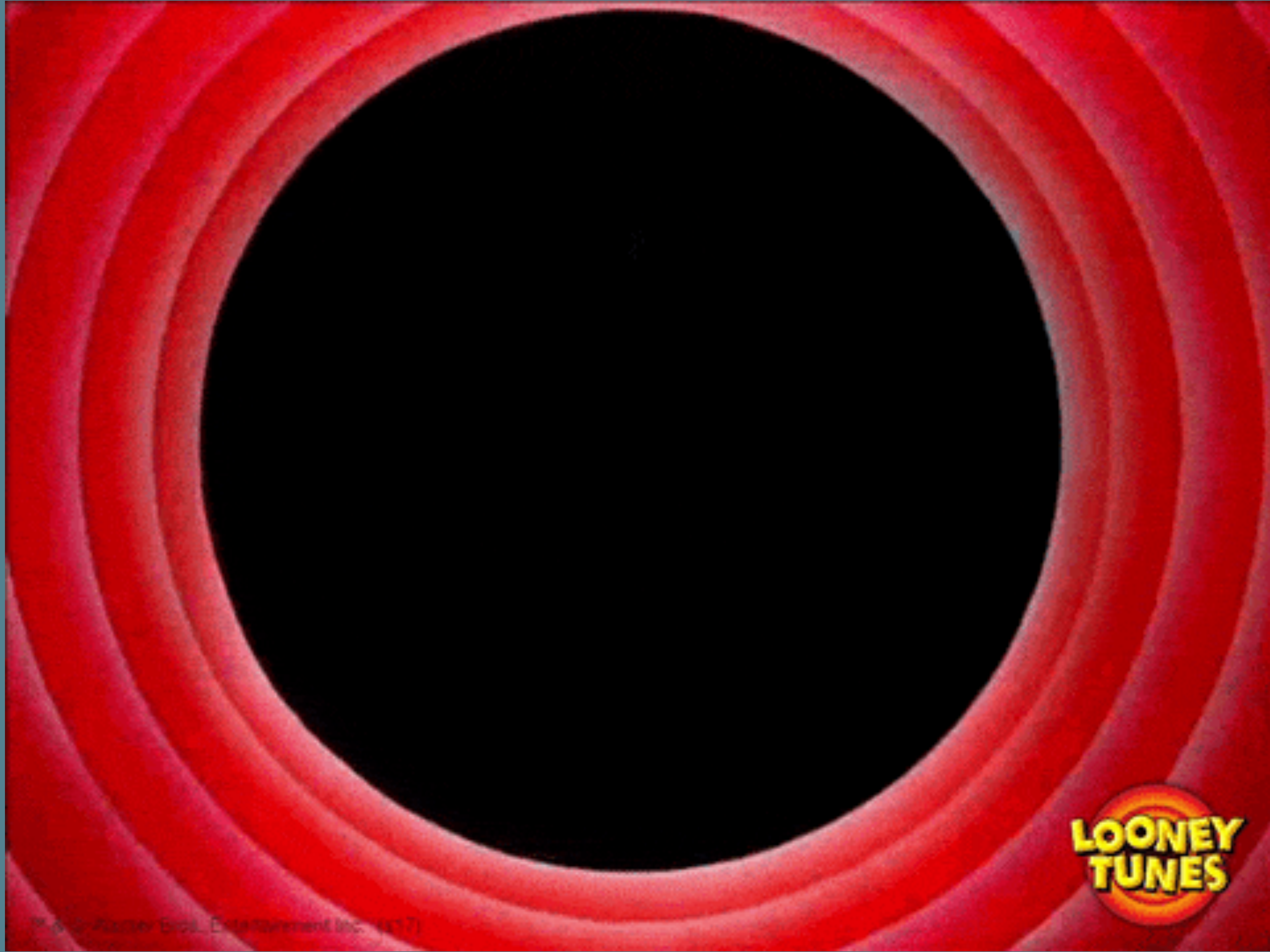
